Combining Sentences With Subordinating Conjunctions

When you write, your writing is more interesting if you can vary sentence structures. One way to vary sentence structures is to combine thoughts using <u>complex sentences</u>. A complex sentence has one complete sentence, or <u>independent clause</u>, and one <u>subordinate clause</u>, which has a subject and a verb but doesn't express a complete thought. It is not independent because to understand the <u>subordinate clause</u>, you need the information in the independent clause. Subordinate clauses are connected to the sentence with <u>subordinating conjunctions</u>.

Example: I have to clean my room <u>because mom said so</u>. The information, "mom said so," only makes sense when connected to the other sentence.
